



WAYS TO USE THIS RESOURCE

Children develop at such different rates. Some develop keen understanding a long time before they show writing readiness and others can write well whilst their reading fluency requires further development.

Here are just 3 suggested ways you can use this resource with your children at different stages. Of course, you know your child best and can adapt it best to their needs.

Stage 1

Read the passage aloud to your child.

Tell them to raise their hand when they don't know a word.

At the end invite them to ask questions.

Then ask them to retell it in their own words.

Then ask the questions that are appropriate to your child from the worksheet.

Either accept oral answers or write their answers for them to copy.

Stage 2

Day 1: The child reads the passage to you the first day.

Day 2: See how much of the passage the child reads to you in 2 minutes. Note it in the tracker. Answer the 1st question page.

Day 3: See how much of the passage the child reads to you in 2 minutes. Note it in the tracker. Answer the 2nd question page.

Day 4: Read passage for 2 mins, Note progress in tracker.


